Carols by Candlelight

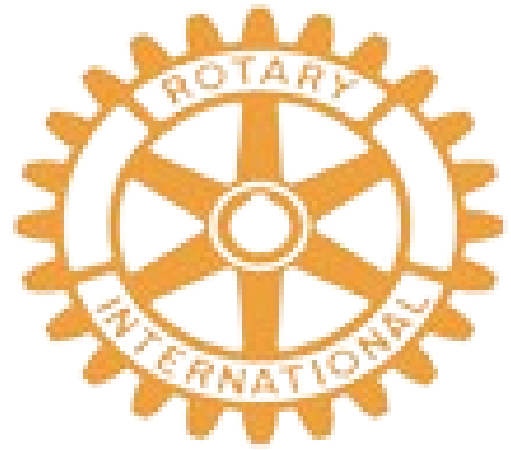
